**Midwest Regional Club - Minutes**  
**June 8th 2007 @ Kirkwood College**  
**Midwest Regional Show, Cedar Rapids, IA**

Midwest Meeting was called to order at 8:00pm by President Mike Hayes. It was announced that there had been some missed meetings and this meeting was to bring things back to order. If anyone had not paid their dues they could still pay them and would be a voting member tonight. Membership dues are \$5.00. Jackie Guthrie gave an overview of the history of the Midwest Club, and when it originated in 1986 to give more support to the Midwest state clubs, and to create a Midwest futurity.

**Treasurer's Report:** Sheryl Quigley reported that the club currently had \$3097.12. The club has donated \$5878 to POAC activities in the last 7 years.

**Secretary Minutes:** read by Becky Victor-Baker to update the members present from 2003. Jackie Guthrie motioned to accept and Kent Rorick seconded. Motion carried. Becky also had some copies of older minutes and a copy of the by-laws.

**Committee Reports:**

**Futurity:** Jackie volunteered to be in charge of this year's futurity. Date and location to be decided later.

**Promotion:** Discussion on to how get this club in better shape, and hope that this meeting is a start.

**National Youth Reporter:** no volunteers

**National Adult Reporter:** Becky Victor-Baker accepted but with everyone understanding that it would not be every month.

Newsletter /Web site: Kent Rorick will check into it and report back.

National Director's Report: Kent Rorick and Judy Katzenberger reported about rules and survey in the last magazine. The board voted to replace the executive secretary and hope to have a new leader by next February. There is a search committee. The new office building has a tenant, thus bringing in some other income. The building of the new office seems to be a good decision. Next Board meeting in July.

More people came in after the inspectors meeting ended, with some questions about the club, so Jackie gave a brief overview again of the Midwest Club for the new people who had just entered, with some discussion on the history again.

**Old Business:** 2007 MWPOAC Futurity Site. Discussion.

Jackie discussed asking the Iowa Club again if they would like to host it, it is only fair, to the Iowa club. Some how there have been some things that have changed or slipped by that need to be cleared up. To clear things up, the MW club only receives the profit for one show (of the 3 shows held), not the entire weekend show. Usually that is Sunday, because most now hold a ponyrama the first day. The club does not receive ½ of the gross. Things could be changed if the members wanted to change it. Jackie motioned to ask IA Club to host the 2007 Futurity, Wanda Victor seconded it. Motioned passed. Jackie will talk with the Iowa president at this show, so a decision can be made, If Iowa does not want to hold it, another state will hold it.

**New Business:** 2007 Event Sponsorships, discussion on what had been sponsored in the past.

Becky Victor-Baker motioned to sponsor \$500.00 for the 2007 International Show. Kent Rorick seconded it and motion passed. Kent Rorick motioned to donate a \$100.00 to the National JFPC futurity in Des Moines and Bonnie Lewis seconded it, motioned passed.

**Futurity:** Jackie also mentioned that we could discuss with the Breeder's Challenge BOD if they would be willing to consider consolidation of dates for future futurity events. It is Wisconsin's turn to host the 2008 MW Futurity; it would be good for everyone to hold it with the New Breeders Challenge Futurity being held in IA that year. But right now it is on a rotational schedule until such time, that the membership would want to change it.

**Elroy Latch Memorial Trophy for Boys:** Becky Victor Baker motioned to donate \$100.00 to the Iowa Club to help pay for the Elroy Latch Boy trophy, that had to be replaced because it was retired last year and the Iowa club had a new one made, then to make the award a traveling trophy, after the next 3 years, so it did not have to be replaced. Both trophies would then be just traveling trophies. After much discussion, on how that would work and what club could make that decision, the motioned was not seconded, motion died. Carroll Koespell motioned to just donate the \$100.00 to the Iowa club only, and Kevin Dykstra seconded it. Motioned passed.

**Amendments to By Laws:**

Jackie motioned to delete the words in Article I, sec. 7 the words "During the month of Sept. each year." Larry Gibson seconded, motion passed.

Jackie also motioned to change in Article I sec.10 "100 active members" to a majority of active members.

Larry Gibson seconded, motion passed.

Members were interested in getting copies of the by-laws and that was discussed and anybody can get a copy.

**Election of Officers:**

**President:** Wanda Victor nominated Kent Rorick, Judy Katzenberger seconded and Lee Ann Haack motioned for nominations to cease. Julius Reed seconded, motion passed. Kent is the new president.

**Vice- President:** Jackie motioned for Mike Hayes to become vice-president and Mike was voted to become vice president. It was discussed that each state should try to be represented on the board (Sorry I did not get anything written down for a second on that nomination.)

**Secretary:** Lee Ann Haack nominated Judy Katzenberger to become secretary, Dawn Walters seconded. Judy was voted in to be the club secretary.

**Treasurer:** Judy Katzenberger nominated Sheryl Quigley for treasurer. Kent Rorick seconded, Sheryl was voted in as Treasurer.

It was mentioned that each office has a 2 year term limit according to the by laws.

**Directors:** The Mid West Club asks that each State club in the Midwest submit a director, it would be nice if it was each state's current president. Julius Reed will be the director for the Minn, Club. The other states will need to submit names.

**Next meeting:** Next meeting will be August 25 2007 in Mason City.

Memberships were still being taken after the meeting but at the end of the meeting, 25 people were present, during most of the meeting.

**Adjournment:** Motion to adjourn meeting by Judy K, and Lee Ann seconded, meeting adjourned at 9:34.
